## **Car parking charges will be suspended in Council-owned car parks in Ormskirk town centre throughout November**

We are keen to support small businesses in Ormskirk town centre selling essential goods and services during the second nationwide coronavirus lockdown.

Parking charges will be suspended from Friday 6 November to Wednesday 2

December. However, we would like to request that residents continue to park

responsibly by parking within marked parking bays during this time.

We want to support those local independent shops that are able to stay open and those that will be able to operate click and collect services during this lockdown."
