(C121 WINIFRED LANE, AUGHTON, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of C121 Winifred Lane, Aughton from a point 120m South East of its junction with A59 Northway, Aughton to C117 Bold Lane, Aughton.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0900 hours until 1500 hours on from Monday 14th December 2020 until Wednesday 16th December 2020 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

C117 Town Green Lane, Aughton – B5197 Prescot Road, South of Aughton – C122 Moss Delph Lane, Aughton – A59 Northway, Aughton and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway inlay works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council – Capital.
